### **Requalification of Surplus Line Insurance Companies Regulatory Bulletin 2016-05 Effective December 16, 2016**

The purpose of this Bulletin is to inform Arizona-licensed surplus lines brokers that the Arizona Department of Insurance (“ADOI”) issued Regulatory Bulletin 2016-05 (accessible from <https://insurance.az.gov/sites/default/files/documents/files/2016-05.pdf>), which describes that the expiration of Arizona Administrative Code R20-6-204, in effect, eliminates the need for a surplus lines broker to submit an annual recertification to the ADOI to keep an insurer on Arizona’s List of Qualified Unauthorized Insurer (“White List”). Consequently, a foreign surplus lines insurer will remain on Arizona’s White List until the surplus lines broker withdraws its certification pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes (“A.R.S.”) 20-413(F), or until the ADOI removes the insurer from the White List pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-413(H), *et al.*
